

## **EEX and Nasdaq Commodities Announce Intention to Transfer Nasdaq's European Power Business to EEX**

**EEX to facilitate transition to zonal futures in Nordic power market to grow area price liquidity**

**New York / Leipzig, 20 June 2023** – The European Energy Exchange (EEX) and Nasdaq, Inc. (Nasdaq: NDAQ) today announced they have reached an agreement under which EEX will acquire Nasdaq's European power trading and clearing business, subject to receipt of customary regulatory approvals. The transaction will involve the transfer of existing open positions in Nasdaq's Nordic, French, and German power futures as well as European carbon emission allowance futures (EUAs) to EEX's clearing house European Commodity Clearing (ECC). No financial details of the deal are disclosed.

Nasdaq Clearing AB, along with the clearing infrastructure to support it, is not part of the sale. Nasdaq will continue to own and operate Nasdaq Clearing AB to provide comprehensive clearing services for Nasdaq Nordic's equity derivatives, fixed income derivatives, and other financial derivatives contracts.

As part of the agreement, EEX will update the current Nordic power market structure, replacing Electricity Price Area Differential (EPAD) contracts with zonal futures contracts, a proven and successful market model in many other European power derivatives markets.

Until the receipt of regulatory approvals, Nasdaq will continue to operate its European power trading and clearing business as usual. On receipt of the required approvals, Nasdaq will inform the market about the timing for the transfer of existing open positions to EEX.

## EEX und Nasdaq beabsichtigen Übertragung des europäischen Stromgeschäfts der Nasdaq zur EEX

**EEX erleichtert den Übergang zu zonalen Futures, um die Liquidität im nordischen Strommarkt zu erhöhen**

**New York / Leipzig, 20. Juni 2023** - Die European Energy Exchange (EEX) und Nasdaq, Inc. (Nasdaq: NDAQ) geben bekannt, dass sie eine Vereinbarung getroffen haben, nach der EEX das europäische Stromhandels- und Clearinggeschäft von Nasdaq übernehmen wird, vorbehaltlich der üblichen behördlichen Genehmigungen. Die Transaktion beinhaltet die Übertragung bestehender offener Positionen in den nordischen Stromfutures der Nasdaq, den französischen und deutschen Stromfutures sowie den europäischen CO<sub>2</sub>-Emissionsfutures (EUA) in das EEX-Clearinghaus European Commodity Clearing (ECC). Finanzielle Einzelheiten der Vereinbarung werden nicht bekannt gegeben.

Nasdaq Clearing AB sowie die sie unterstützende Clearing-Infrastruktur sind nicht Teil der Akquisition. Nasdaq verbleibt Eigentümer und Betreiber von Nasdaq Clearing AB, um weiterhin umfangreiche Clearing-Dienstleistungen für Nasdaq Nordics Aktienderivate, Fixed-Income-Derivate und weitere finanzielle Derivatekontrakte anbieten zu können.

Im Rahmen der Vereinbarung wird die EEX die aktuelle Marktstruktur im nordischen Strommarkt überarbeiten und Electricity Price Area Differential (EPAD)-Kontrakte durch zonale Futures-Kontrakte ersetzen, die schon ein bewährtes und erfolgreiches Marktmodell in vielen anderen Stromterminmärkten sind.

Bis zur Erteilung der behördlichen Genehmigungen wird Nasdaq den Betrieb des europäischen Stromhandels- und Clearinggeschäfts wie gehabt fortführen. Nasdaq wird den Markt über den Erhalt der Genehmigungen informieren und den Zeitplan für die Übertragung der bestehenden offenen Positionen an die EEX bekanntgeben.
